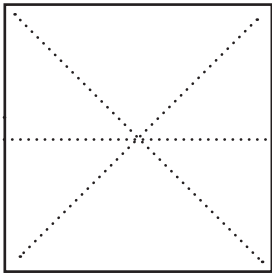




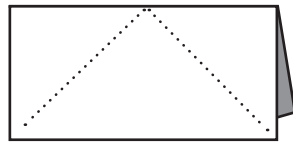

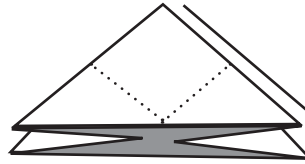
## Origami Butterfly



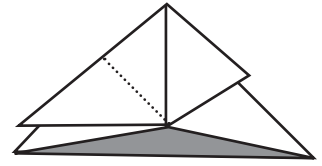
**1.** Fold your piece of paper in half diagonally both sides and from top to bottom



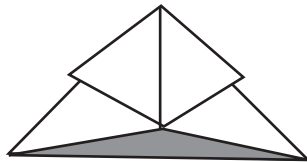
**2.** Your paper should look like this now...



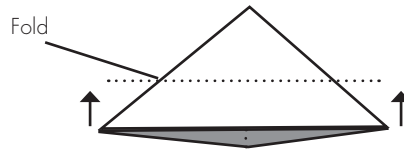
**3.** Then take the top right corner and fold it on itself to the inside. Do this with the left top corner too.



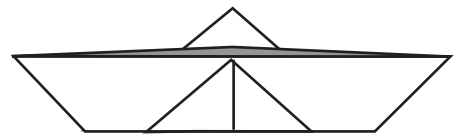
**4.** Take top layers, bottom right corner and fold it to the top of the triangle, do this with the other side as well.



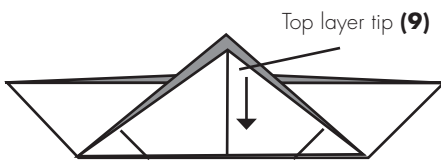
**5.** Your paper should look like this...



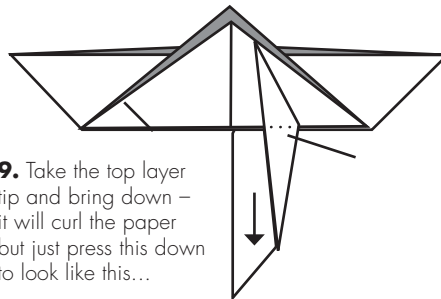
**6.** Turn over the paper and fold in half – but leave about a thumb space of room at the top



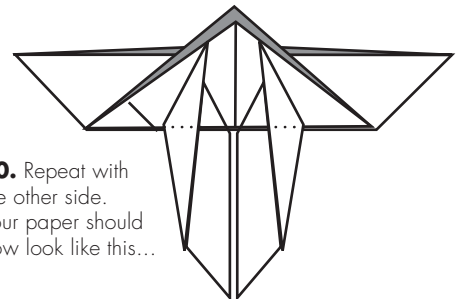
**7.** Your paper should look like this...



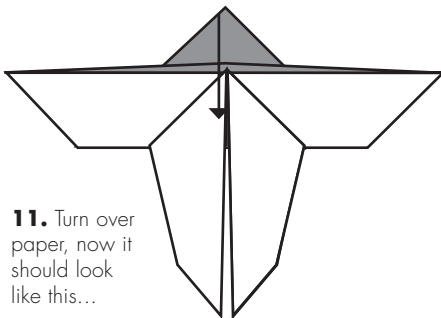
**8.** Turn your paper over...



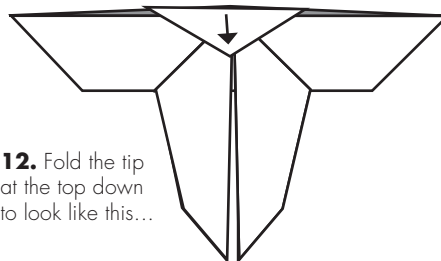
**9.** Take the top layer tip and bring down – it will curl the paper but just press this down to look like this...



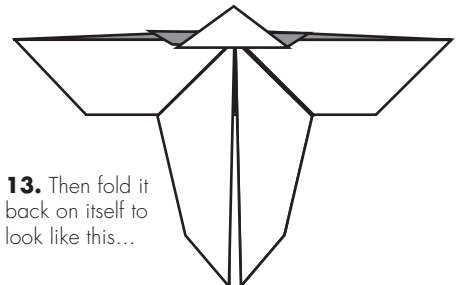
**10.** Repeat with the other side. Your paper should now look like this...



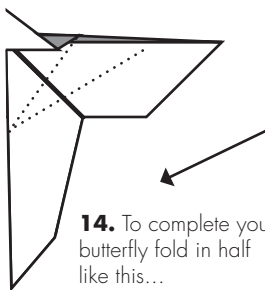
**11.** Turn over paper, now it should look like this...



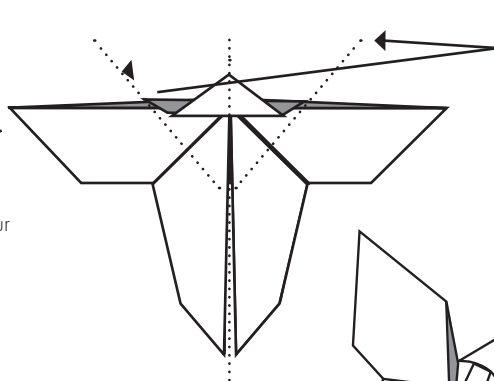
**12.** Fold the tip at the top down to look like this...



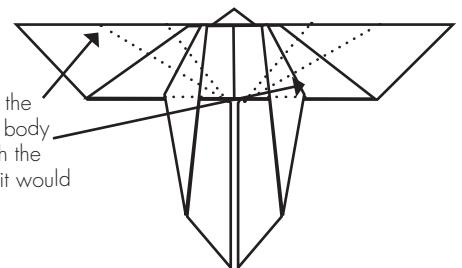
**13.** Then fold it back on itself to look like this...



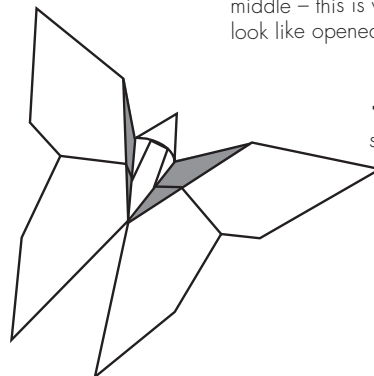
**14.** To complete your butterfly fold in half like this...



**15.** Then fold back on itself at the 2 lines shown



**16.** Finally fold back the wings down from the body so that it is in line with the middle – this is what it would look like opened up



**17.** Your butterfly should now look like this...
