

# Rib Beanie



## MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Head	cm	58
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## MATERIALS

### CLECKHEATON PERFECT DAY 8 PLY 50g balls

Quantity	3
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Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 **set** of 4.00mm (UK 8) **double-pointed** knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing in ends.

## TENSION

This Beanie has been designed at a tension of 34 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over 4x4 rib (slightly stretched), using 4.00mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 4.00mm needles, cast on 52 sts.

**1st row** - K4, \* P4, K4, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** - P4, \* K4, P4, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib. Work a further 42 rows.

Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.

## BEANIE

Using **set** of 4.00mm **double-pointed** needles, cast on 128 sts and divide as evenly as possible between 3 needles. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist cast-on edge.

**1st round** - \* K4, P4, rep from \* to end.

Rep last round until Beanie measures 23cm from beg.



## Shape Crown -

**1st round** - \* K4, P2, P2tog, rep from \* to end ... 112 sts.

**2nd round** - \* K4, P3, rep from \* to end.

**3rd round** - As 2nd round.

**4th round** - \* K2, K2tog, P3, rep from \* to end ... 96 sts.

**5th round** - \* K3, P3, rep from \* to end.

**6th round** - As 5th round.

**7th round** - \* K3, P1, P2tog ... 80 sts.

**8th round** - \* K3, P2, rep from \* to end.

**9th round** - As 8th round.

**10th round** - \* K1, K2tog, P2, rep from \* to end ... 64 sts.

**11th round** - \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

**12th round** - As 11th round.

**13th round** - \* K2tog, P2tog, rep from \* to end ... 32 sts.

**14th round** - \* K2tog, rep from \* to end ... 16 sts.

**15th round** - As 14th round ... 8 sts.

Break off yarn, thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

## TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends. Turn brim onto right side.
