

TRIANGLE SCARF

■■ Easy

MEASUREMENTS

145cm wide and 55cm long at deepest point.

PATONS BOHEMIA 100g hanks

Quantity 1

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 10mm (UK 000) knitting needles.
- wool needle for sewing in ends.
- needle and thread (optional).

TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this Scarf.

SCARF

Wind your hank carefully into a ball, taking care to avoid tangles. You will notice that each of the different yarns that make up Bohemia are knotted together where they join. When knitting, these knotted ends can be left for effect, alternatively the ends can be neatly secured with needle and thread after you cast off. If necessary, re-tie knots firmly.

Beg Scarf –

Using 10mm needles, cast on 2 sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st (1 row knit, 1 row purl).

Beg Shaping –

1st row – Inc in each st ... 4 sts.

2nd row – Inc in first st, purl to last st, inc in last st ... 6 sts.

3rd row – Inc in first st, knit to last st, inc in last st ... 8 sts.

Repeat last 2 rows until there are approx 138 sts, making sure there is enough yarn remaining for cast off (approx 5 metres will be required).

Cast off **very loosely**.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using a sewing needle and matching thread, stitch ends in place (if desired).
