

## Felt horse

This wee horse is super easy to make. All you need is felt, cotton and stuffing (you can use the stuffing from an old cushion). We've even supplied the pattern for you to download. Just click on the link provided to print.



- 1 Cut out the pattern and place on top of felt. We've used two contrasting felt colours for the back and front. Cut 2 horse shapes.

- 2 Pin the two cut pieces together then, starting from the inside front leg, run around the horse shape, close to the edge, with a zigzag stitch (we've used a contrasting coloured cotton). At the mane and tail, sew at the base, not on the edges, leaving the two edges free (as shown). Continue sewing until you reach the inside back leg.



- 3 Cut the edges of the mane and tail into a fringe. Stuff the body then sew the belly shut. If you wish, you can stitch on embellishments such as a felt rug with cute buttons.
